What do you hear?

What do you hear?

While you're at the Trafalgar Branch of JCPL, notice if you see any birds visiting the prairie... what do they look like? Are the calling to each other? Write or draw your obeservations below!

What do you see?

While you're at Johnson Co Park, notice if it seems like the trees are being crowded. Does this look natural? Are there any areas that look more open?
